How we can help:

At Stop Domestic Abuse we understand the trauma that can result from FGM/C. We also understand that women and girls could live in fear of being cut, or being forced to cut their daughters against their will. We provide 1-2-1 sensitive, emotional support to survivors of FGM/C who come forward. We also empower women and girls to make decisions about their own bodies by providing them with information about their rights, protection and the law.

Stop Domestic Abuse provides sensitive and approachable staff of BME origin so do not hesitate to contact us.

Although FGM/C is often done with good intentions, it is child abuse in the UK. FGM/C is illegal, with a maximum penalty of 14 years in prison for anyone found guilty of the offence. It is also illegal to take a British national or permanent resident abroad for FGM/C, to help someone trying to do this or to fail to protect a girl from the risk of FGM/C.



Female Genital Mutilation/
Cutting (FGM/C) includes the partial or total removal of the female external genitalia for non-medical reasons.

HEALTH COMPLICATIONS INCLUDE:

- Severe pain and shock
- Urine retention
- Injury to adjacent tissues
- · Fracture or dislocation as a result of restraint
- Haemorrhage
- Infection
- Death
- Extensive damage of the external reproductive system
- · Infertility due to infections
- Pelvic pain
- Uterus, vaginal and pelvic infections
- · Complications in pregnancy and child birth
- Difficulties in menstruation
- Urinary tract infections (UTIs)
- Anger at the person who performed FGM/C or arranged for FGM/C to be carried out.
- Feelings of not being a 'whole' or a 'normal' girl or woman
- Emotional distress, fear, and feelings of helplessness
- Difficulties in sexual relations due to pain associated with FGM/C
- Flash backs, nightmares, anxiety and depression for a long time after FGM (known as Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, PTSD)
